Pray for Us

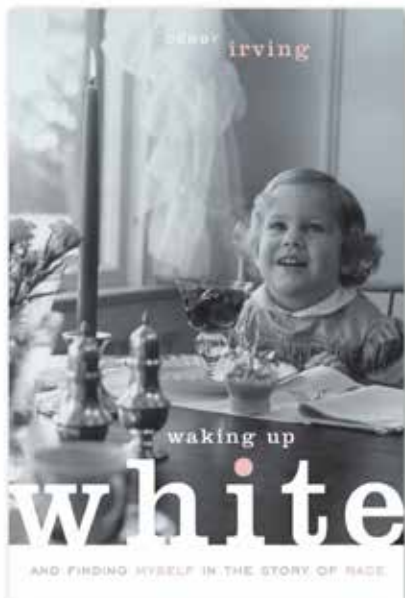

Financial Update

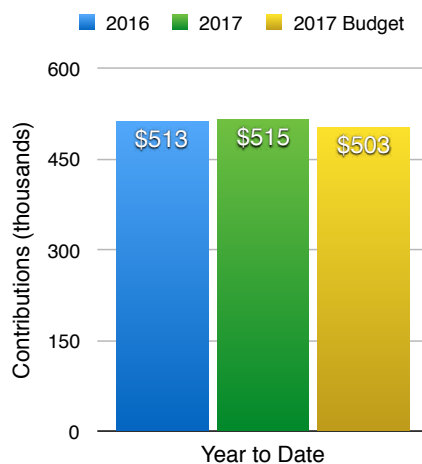
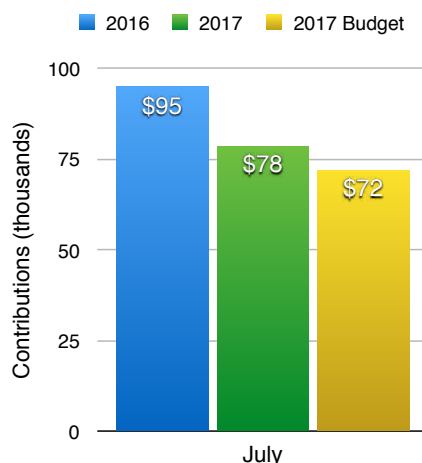
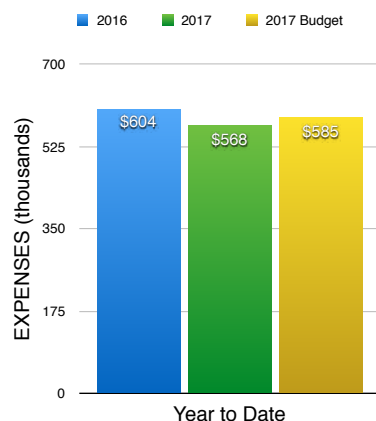

Contributions

Contributions in July were \$17K less than 2016 but \$6K above the budget at \$78K. The Year to Date total continues positive in 2017. This exceeded last year by \$2K and the budgeted amount by \$12K. The increase in this year's contributions continue to offset the decrease in prepaid pledges (those paid in the year prior to the pledge year) for 2017 compared to 2016. These pre-paid pledges are prorated over the year with 1/12 added to each month's contributions.

Expenses

Year to Date expenses are \$17K below budget at \$568K and \$36K below 2016. Considering all sources, revenue exceeds expenses by \$60K which is \$37K more than at this time in 2016. This figure includes a \$29K transfer from other funds that was not made last year.
